BEFORE YOU REGISTER YOU NEED TO COMPLETE ALL TRAININGS BELOW

STEP 1: GET 2023 CONCUSSION CERTIFICATE (CC) - YEP YOU HAVE TO DO THIS EVERY YEAR

STEP 2: GET "SAFE SPORT TRAINED" CERTIFICATE (SST) - EITHER A 2023 REFRESHER CERT OR YOUR FIRST TIME MASTER CERT - SAFESPORT

Each Summit | FC team to include our Partner Clubs: Atletico, MetaSport, SWAT, Vipers, and L30 Legacy is required to have a HEAD COACH and an ASST COACH with a Concussion Certificate (CC), Safe Sport Trained Certificate (SS) & the necessary Coaching License (see Step 3) for the team to be registered in Affinity/Sports Connect.

It is strongly encouraged that each team have a registered TEAM MGR to help with team communication, organization & scheduling. <u>Team Managers MUST complete SafeSport and Concussion Training</u>. It is up to individual teams to decide if they will have TRAINERS or other DEVELOPMENTAL STAFF helping with the team. *EVERYONE assisting with the team must also be registered volunteers in Affinity (which prompts a background check) and have completed their Concussion and Safe Sport Certification.* This is NOT negotiable. Failure to comply with these mandatory volunteer requirements will result in disciplinary action, to include but not limited to suspensions or the inability to renew a team with Summit FC in the future. This best practice is in place for the protection of both the volunteers and the players. Your compliance is both required & appreciated.

AFTER COMPLETION OF TRAINING – save certificates to upload during registration process.

STEP 3: DO I HAVE THE CORRECT LICENSE IN ORDER TO COACH (CLICK HERE)?

Fall 2023 Spring 2024: If you are a **Current or New Team please submit your Summit FC Team Request here!!** Allow 2-3 business days to receive email confirmation that your team has been set up for the Fall 2022 Spring 2023 Seasonal year. This email will have the assignment codes you need for STEP 4. YOU CAN NOT MOVE TO STEP 4 UNTIL ASSIGNMENT CODES HAVE BEEN EMAILED and registration is open based on UYSA's tryout policy date. The new requirements for team size can be found below.

- U7 Academy 4 players required to activate (4v4)
- U8 Academy 5 players required to activate (4v4)
- U9-U10 9min 12max players (7v7)
- U11-U12 11min 15max players (9v9)
- U13-U14 13min 18max players (11v11)
- U15-U19 13min 22max players (11v11)

COACH FAQS EXAMPLE TRYOUT OFFER (CLICK HERE)

Tryouts Offers must include the following:

- (1) The date of the offer;
- (2) The name, age group, anticipated coach and anticipated level of the Team for whom the offer is made (notice of the level of Team made is not necessary for X-league teams*);
- (3) The time period in which the player must respond to the offer, which may not be less than 48 hours.

Note: A player can accept a tryout offer immediately, but they don't HAVE to. You must hold their spot on the team for 48 hours, after which you can decide whether or not to extend the original offer timeframe or move on to another player.

*UYSA policy doesn't require you to provide expected level or division for U9-U12. Summit FC prefers that if you have an expected division that you include it. Because there are a lot of new teams forming in these age groups, UYSA does not require it.
